

Mason.


Mrs Davies will teach either French, Re or Computing on a Wedneday afternoon




Forest School is on a Friday afternoon. Class 1 sessions will be in the Summer term. Class 2 sessions will be Spring term.

Home Learning

Reading: Children are expected to read a colour banded book or library book to an adult at least three times a week. Year 3 children who are accessing our phonics programme will be sent home with a series of texts that relate to the phonics they have been learning that week. Reading records will be checked on weekly by an adult.

Maths: Children will be expected to complete some Mathletics. **TBC**

Some children may also be given a spelling activity (to support their learning.


Topics


