# English:

In English we are continuing a focus on space and science fiction. In whole class reading, we will be exploring Phoenix by S.F. Said. In writing lessons, we are writing a narrative based on the silent animation <u>'One Small Step'</u>. World Book Day is on the 7th March! For this day, we will focus on the language of nature through 'The Lost Words' by Rob McFarlane.

### Science:
