English: In English we will be focusing on magazine articles. The children will look at a modelled text about natural disasters and will then write their own article about climate change in Antarctica. This book will inspire us to look at the nature around us, the vocabulary used to describe it and from that we will write our own poems.

Maths: We will start the half term looking at money - adding and subtracting it as well as solving word problems. We will then move on to fractions counting in tenths, finding equivalent fractions, comparing and ordering fractions as well as adding and subtracting fractions. As always, we will continue to work on the children's quick recall of times tables as well as regularly practicing the strategies for adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing we have already learnt this year.


