3. Ideas about after-school care provision

JP explained the after-school care currently being given by LOSC. The children are walked to LVC and we would like this care to be done at Linton Heights. This would possibly still be supervised by the LOSC, an external company or teaching assistants.

AB – Can children do a sports club and then join the after-school club?

JP – Yes they can.

AB – Which clubs do we currently have and could we do more? - All agreed we do already run lots of clubs (at least 2 a day).

JP – We would need staff to run more clubs and are dictated by the availability of Prestige Sports.

4. Class selection process

AB – Prefers TT Rockstars to Mathletics. - JP has listened to general feedback and most parents are happy with the new system. Maths needs improving across the school so we are working on that and having a break from the red home learning book as English/writing has improved massively.

6. Toilets

HB – asked for feedback from parents on the year 4 What's App group; toilets need a deep clen, no soap, no paper towels, children would rather hold their bladder all day than use them, would rather use money to revamp toilets than art room.

JP – We have a new external cleaning company just started so this will hopefully now improve. I will talk to Mr Filby re soap and paper towels and have been looking at getting new units, sinks, toilet bowls and possibly re-tiling.

HB – An idea might be to remove the urinals and use a trough system.

7. Comments from parents

HB – What is the selection process for choosing children to take part in sport tournaments? Lots of children who are good at sport are not being chosen.

JP – We have widened the criteria but need to ensure we are covering the Sen and 'non-sporty' children so that everyone gets a chance.
