English: In English we will be looking at poetry for the first few weeks. The inspiration for our poetry will be taken from "Still I Rise" by Maya Angelou. Our whole class reading text will be The Stolen Spear by Saviour Pirotta, We will also study a range of classic children's books such as Matilda and The Enchanted Wood. We will finish the half term with a reading café where the children will be invited to bring in a book of their choice to read for pleasure.

Maths: Year 4 will begin by finishing the unit on decimals, specifically rounding decimals and writing fractions as decimals. After that, we will begin a unit on money. Pupils will be comparing amounts of money and rounding to the nearest $\pounds I$ and $\pounds I0$. We will also build in opportunities for problem solving. Next will we complete work on geometry; comparing angles, classifying shapes and finding lines of symmetry.
