Music is on a Wednesday. This is taught by Mrs Mason.

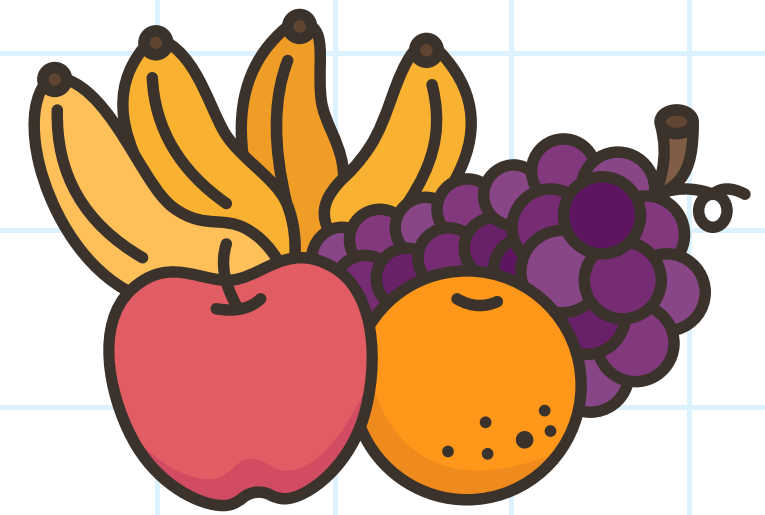


Forest School is on a Friday afternoon. Class 1 sessions will be in the Spring 1 term. Class 2 sessions will be Autumn 2 term.

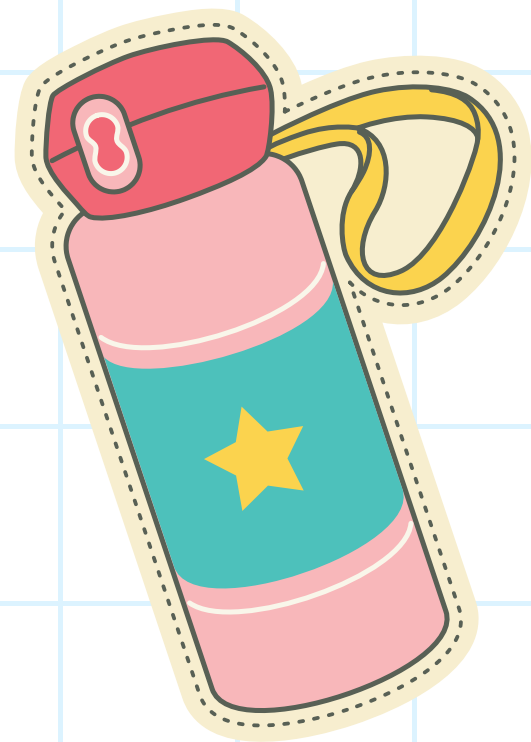


Wellbeing and RE is on a Wednesday. This is taught by Mr Barnes.
