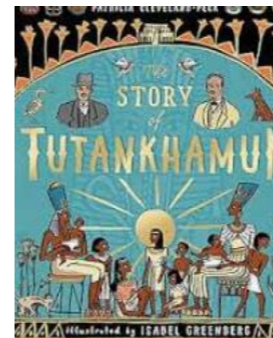
What happens when we do wrong?
