Food and Drink

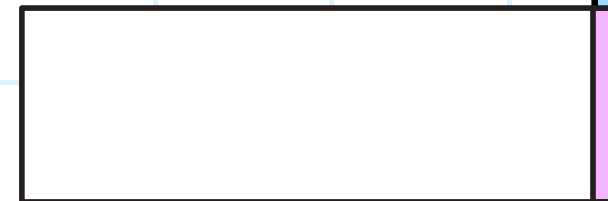
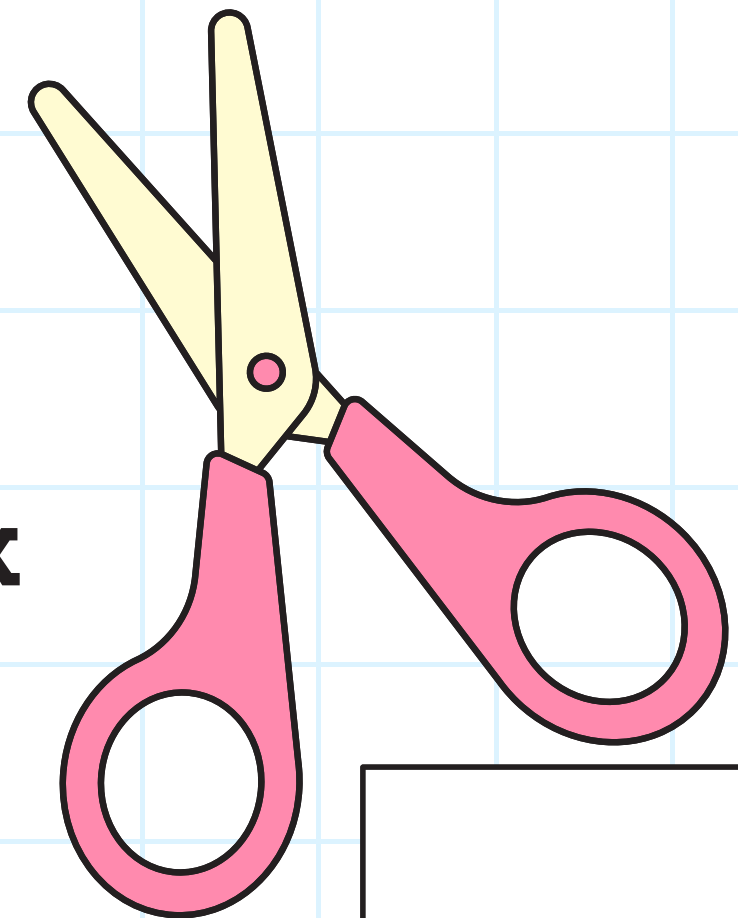

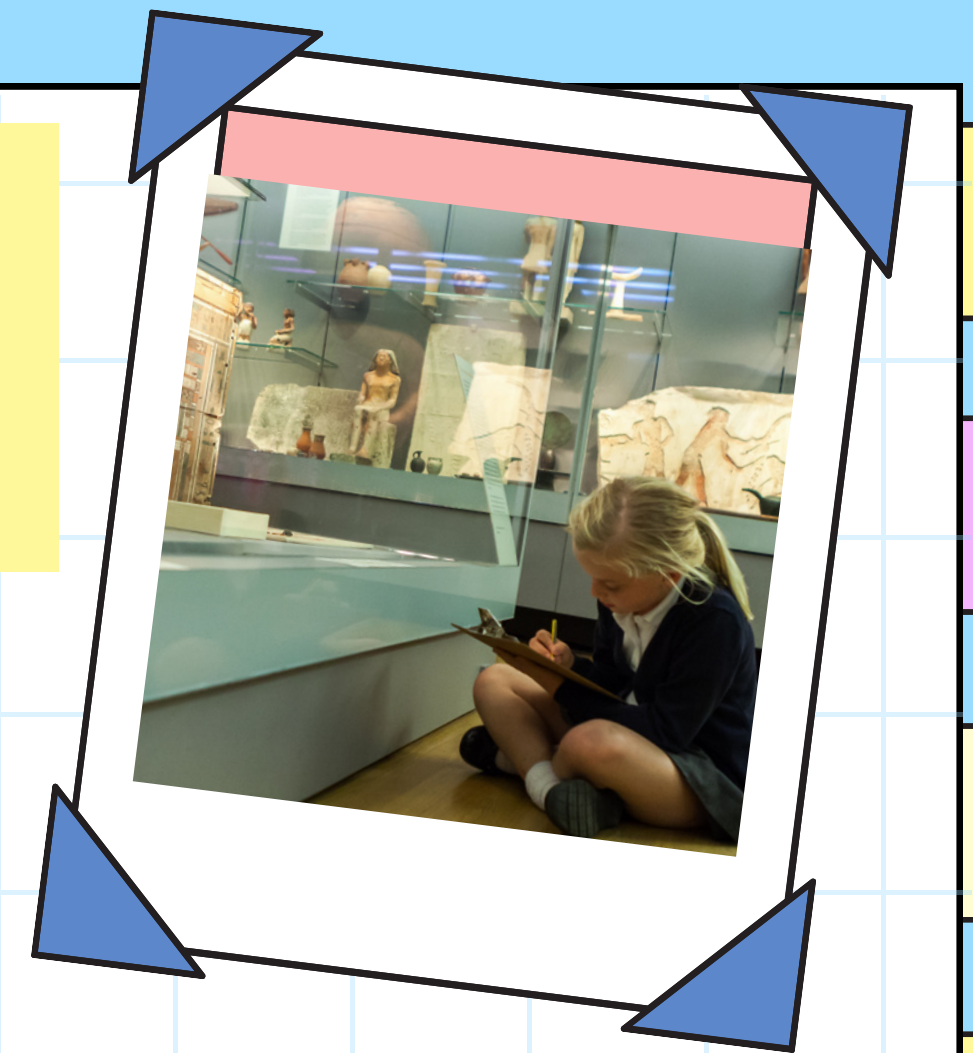
Subject Units

Topics continue to be studied for a half term. Geography units will be: Populations, Energy and Oceans. History units will be: the Tudors, Ancient Greece and the Vikings.

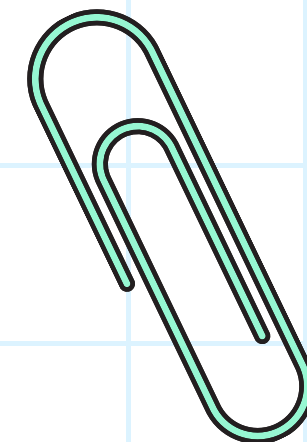


Trips and other events

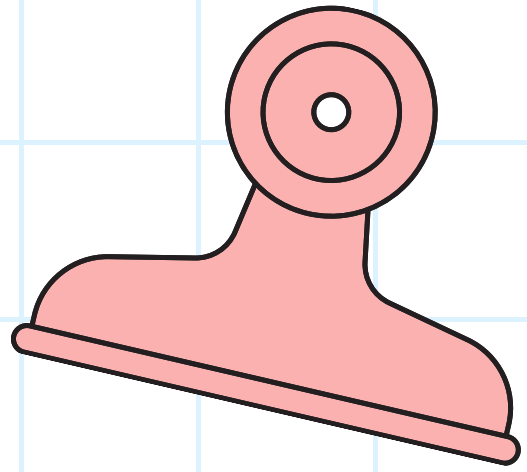
The good news is that we plan to give Year 5 lots of other lovely enrichment opportunities as outlined in the previous slide.

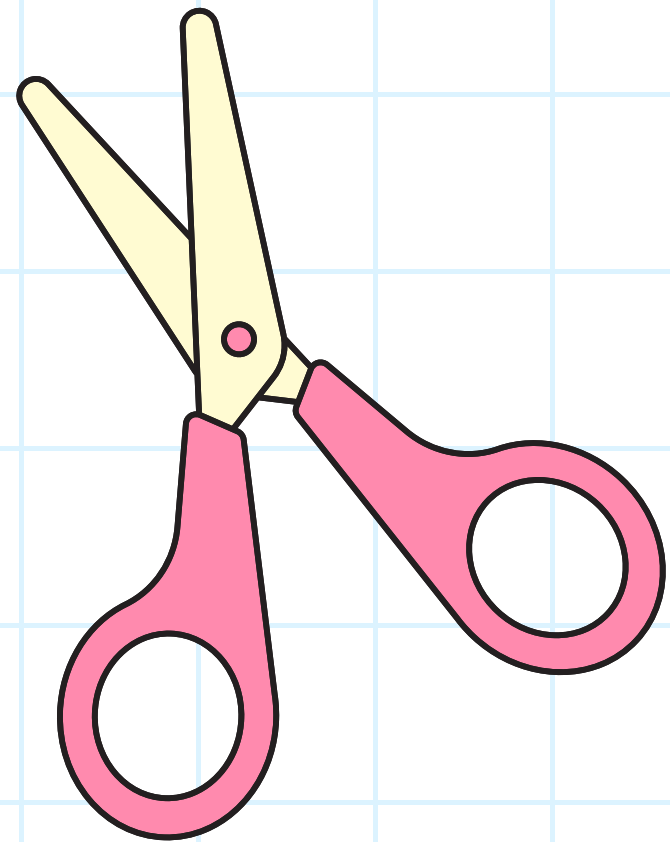
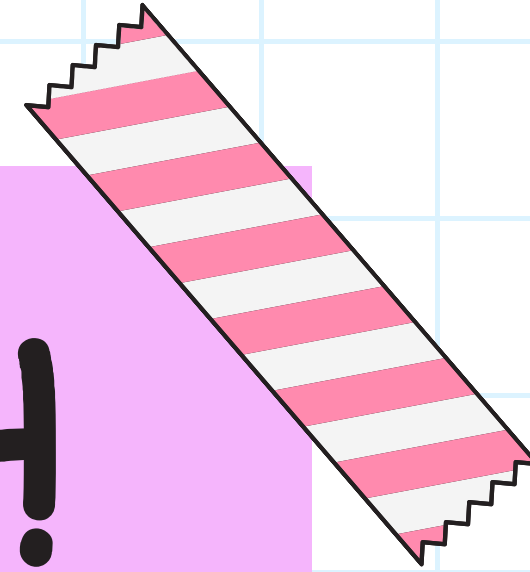
