English: In English, we will be reading The boy, the Mole, the Fox and the Horse by Charlie Mackesy. We will be focusing on developing our narrative skills and work towards writing a continuation of the story or writing the story from a different viewpoint. After, we will move on to a poetry unit about dangerous animals. In Whole Class Reading, we will be looking at a range of text types: The Highwayman, classic books such as Peter Pan and the Wizard of Oz, songs and Christmas Carols. The children will also have a chance to choose a book of their choice for our class book.

Maths:

In Maths, we will be continuing with the unit covering Multiplication and Division started towards the end of last half term. We will be focusing on mental mathematic skills in solving multiplication and division sums before revisiting and learning new strategies for formal written methods for calculation. Following this, we will be exploring Statistics and Graphs as we look at unpicking and problem-solving with data and embedding new vocabulary and new challenges.


