CLASSES



Classes will be mixed coming into Year 3 and every year after.

SCHOOL DAY



Our gate opens at 8:20am and children go straight into their classrooms. The register is taken at 8:30am.

Break time is 10:15am until 10:30am

Lunch is 12:10pm until 1pm.

The school day ends at 3pm

Parents are welcome to come on to the grounds at the beginning and the end of the day. We ask children to wait with their teacher until they have seen the adult they are going with.

FOOD & DRINKS
